

On your mark, get set and shoot! The NDSA is now accepting entries for its annual Photography Contest. Entries will be evaluated in a people's-choice format at the 2019 NDSA Annual Convention & Trade Show Sept. 19-21 in Minot. The winners will be announced during the general session on Sept. 21.

First, second and third place photographs will be selected and awarded \$100, \$75 and \$50, respectively.

Entries must be 8-inch-by-10-inch or 8-inch-by-12-inch prints, rural or livestock related and taken in North Dakota. Glossy photographs are preferred over those with matte finishes; however, both types are accepted.

Entries must include a three-line address, phone number and e-mail address and be mailed to 407 S. Second St., Bismarck, ND 58504 by Sept. 1.

All entries become the property of the NDSA, with all rights to the photographs.
