

#### KOESTER RED ANGUS

First stop, Oct. 6

Koester Red Angus combines over 20 years of genomic DNA testing with practical, hands-on selection to deliver bulls that perform both on paper and in the pasture. While advanced data drives our decisions, we never compromise structure, muscle or phenotype. Our bulls are built to produce efficient, high-performing cattle and long-lasting females — ensuring commercial cattlemen get results that are as reliable as they are profitable.

We run an all-registered, fall-calving herd near Steele, with cows calving on pasture in August and September. Sale bulls are summered on grass and developed slowly, then marketed as 18-month-olds the second Friday of March in conjunction with Leland Red Angus near Sidney, Montana (March 13, 2026).

Our breeding program is backed by more than two decades of genomic testing and disciplined selection. Each mating is planned using the RightMate program, with careful attention to performance and carcass genomics, phenotype and pedigree. We time-breed via AI in November, sort into sire groups, and pull herd bulls in early January. Cows are pregnancy ultrasounded in February, and calves are weaned in the spring.

All bulls and heifers are DNA tested to improve the accuracy of their EPDs, giving our customers greater confidence and predictability in their calf crops. We're strict on structure and disposition, and only the soundest, most complete bulls make the cut. Customers consistently report that our age-advantaged bulls hold up well, sire fast-growing calves, and leave behind females that last.

Our family remains at the core of our operation. Daughters Kacey and Shaye are both married and actively involved in agriculture. Kacey and her husband, Jake Jacobson, live in Max, ND, and operate a commercial Red Angus ranch with Jake's parents. Shaye and her husband, Phillip Wanner, farm and ranch with Phillip's family near Wishek, ND, and Shaye continues to help with chores and cattle work. We look forward to welcoming two grandsons to the family.

Steve previously served as Region 5 Director and president of the Red Angus Association of America. Tracey operates Cow Camp Promotions, helping fellow seedstock producers with sale promotion and marketing strategies. She also produces the Red Angus Magazine.

Today the operation is run by Bob and Jodi Weigel, along with their sons Drew, who works closely with the herd, and Devin and his wife Katie, who are taking over the farming side of the operation.

Our goal of creating practical, predictable, and profitable Angus cattle dictates how mating decisions are made here. Structure, foot, and udder quality, along with disposition are some of the traits needed to create practical cattle that will produce the right kind of females. We try and create consistent cattle with a similar type, pedigree, and look so you can predict how our bulls will work. In order to create a more profitable herd for our commercial customers, we make cattle that can do a little more with a little less. Cows need to be easy fleshing with lower feed requirements, while still raising a heavy calf with enough performance to pay the bills when you haul them to town. We also place heavy emphasis on the fertility and longevity of our cowherd, which are the largest drivers of profitability in a commercial cow herd. You will find many of the bulls we sell are out of 10+ year old cows, or are out of daughters of 10+ year old cows.

We welcome you all to also attend our annual production sale which takes place the fourth Tuesday in January every year, which will be January 27, 2026. In this sale we sell around 70 registered yearling Angus bulls along with 40 purebred commercial Angus heifers. We also welcome you to give us a call to ask more about our operation and invite you to stop by and view the herd at any time.

In the last couple years, we have made some major changes to our calving dates and annual production sale. We now start calving May 1 and then sell bulls and bred females at 18 months old in the fall (November 15, 2025 is this year's sale). This model gives us a much bigger window to slowly develop the bulls and females with no creep feed and evaluate foot structure, disposition, and fertility, ultimately offering a more mature, problem free herd sire.

We heavily utilize embryo transplant to quickly propagate multiple sons and daughters of our leading donors, building uniformity and consistency into our cow herd and the bull offering.

Our herd sires and cow herd are a majority three-quarters to purebred simmentals. That being said, the crossing of Simmentals on Angus and Red Angus is in our opinion, the ultimate cross. You can easily create an easy keeping, functional, and PROFITABLE animal. Our goal is to take that ideal "SimAngus" type of animal and breed high percentage or purebred Simmentals in that same mold. We want a modern day Simmental cow that is average in size with as much body, capacity and bred in performance to be useful no matter where in the U.S. she could be working. Along with the fundamental necessities of quality foot and udders, we pay close attention to carcass quality, maternal calving ease, milk, and performance. As you study our program, we hope you see the commitment we have, working to breed well balanced cattle that have much to offer to the industry.

Our program consists of 250 Angus and 15 Hereford dams. As our numbers got smaller, our genetics improved significantly because we have embraced embryo transplant and flushing through the years. We have gone to private treaty sales offering 40-50

bulls and a significant amount of embryo sales. You typically will see several embryo lots and donor dams marketed in the North Dakota Angus Select Sale.

The goal at TLC Angus has always been to breed and develop cattle that are functional, powerful, big-footed and gentle. Our bull calves and heifers are also not creep fed. #### KALBERER RANCH

Sixth stop, Oct. 6

Welcome to the 2025 All Breeds Cattle Tour and the Kalberer Ranch, operated by Jesse Kalberer with support from my wife Susan and our three children.

Our goal is to raise maternal Red Angus cattle that can have a great impact on our customers' bottom line. We have found that the genetics we use from Ohlde Cattle Company provide the proven platform we need for our cow herd. They are moderate framed, low input cows with good udders and feet. Don't get me wrong, they're not all perfect, but we're trying. The bulls are



bred and raised to build a profitable herd of cows.

We calve on grass, starting at the end of April for 45 days. Pairs go to summer pastures at the beginning of June, and we do not creep the calves. We practice rotational grazing, so the pairs are moved to a new paddock every 5 to 7 days.

We wean in December and the cows go back to grazing on stockpiled grass and season long cover crops for the rest of the winter. Our goal is to graze the cows year-round without feeding hay (which we accomplished for the first time last year). We expect cows to hold their condition all winter and raise a healthy calf without any pampering or help from us. If she doesn't she's culled.

The weaned calves are fed chopped hay and cover crop bales, no grain or silage. We want them to grow and express their genetics without pushing them.

The bull calves are fed hay and cover crop bales through the winter, then put out to pasture with the herd bulls in May. The following December they are separated from the herd bulls and penned closer to the farm to prepare them to be sold as 2-year-olds at our sale in April.

Bottom line is, we want cows that work for us, not vice-versa. "Low input" isn't a tag line, it's what we expect of our cattle.

#### BICHLER SIMMENTALS

Seventh stop, Oct. 6



Bichler Simmentals is owned and operated by Doug and Maria Bichler and is located in south central North Dakota. The ranch consists of 250 mother cows, which are comprised of both registered and commercial females. The Bichlers' program has grown significantly in the past 20 years. Since they began their production sale in 2005, they have been able to increase the number of bulls and bred heifers they offer and create more genetic and phenotypic consistent cattle. They use extensive embryo transfer to ensure they are propagating their best genetics.


In 2020, the Bichlers changed their program out of necessity. Between harsh calving seasons, limited labor, cow/calf health, and their mental and physical well-being, they needed to do something different. Their solution has been to calve in May and June and offer bulls and bred heifers for sale each November. They have witnessed a tremendous difference in the health of their cowherd and calf crop due to calving in warmer temperatures and on grass.

Their philosophy is that quality is always centered around the cowherd. That is why they cull heavily for not only performance and genetics but for relevant traits important to their customers such as disposition, udder quality and structural soundness. Any females failing to meet these requirements are either moved into the recipient herd or are simply culled. They believe the best performing cattle are moderate framed, easy fleshing and deep bodied. They flush superior cows in their herd to produce superior females which in turn are mated to produce bulls for the purebred and commercial producer alike.

Their annual production sale is held the third Monday of November at the ranch near Linton.



Welcome to H7 Angus Ranch! We are very excited to host you all and tell you a little about us during this year's All Breeds Cattle Tour.

The ranch started in 1952 with Pete and Lucille Thomas (Shawn's maternal grandparents). In 1980, Rick and Gail married and started the 2nd generation of farming and ranching. Shawn, the only boy of 4 children, came back to the ranch full-time in 2008 beginning the 3rd generation. Shawn and Lindy got married in 2018 and have 3 children, Coy (8), Ryatt (5) and Sloan (1).

In 2014, Shawn started Aling the commercial Angus cows and heifers in hopes to build up the females in numbers and genetics. This passion really stuck with him and he continued to be able to keep back a few more heifers each year.

We purchased our first registered heifer in 2018, 6 Mile Tour of Duty. "Peach" is the starting foundation of what we pride ourselves on. She has been such a huge asset to our operation.

2019 brought our embryo transfer journey, thanks to "Peach." Many 'thanks' to TransOva, Dr. Travis (TK Veterinary Services) and Nevada Miller for being with us from the beginning. This journey brought on a goal to eventually sell high quality bulls out of a strong set of females.

From 2019 to 2023, Shawn strived for perfection. Each year he said, "I think we are getting closer to that goal." And in 2023, we finally had the calf crop he was ready to advertise. We brought 4 bull calves out to Midland Bull Test. In 2024, we brought 8 bull calves out. Lot 321 was WDA Runner up – Group 2. Lot 323 was Low Birth ADG Runner up – Group 2. Lots 321, 322, and 323 were Champion Sire Group Runner up – Group 2. Buyers from North Dakota, South Dakota and Wyoming purchased our bulls and we couldn't have been happier.

For 2025, we will be bringing out 12 bulls to Midland Bull Test. We are excited to see how they progress and where they will go!

None of our accomplishments would have been possible without the help of Rick and Gail (Dad and Mom). They are such a staple in our operation and whether it's cattle or kids, they are all-in.
